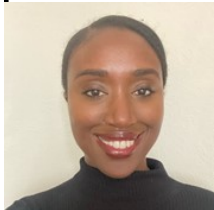
### **SAFEGUARDING:**

**Uniform** Can I just remind everyone that footwear should be black shoes or completely black trainers. There should be no other colours on footwear, including brand names and logos, unless they are also black. The children only need to bring their red school book bag into school each day - **no back packs please—there is not enough room!** Jewellery is unsafe in school and can cause injury to your child or one of their friends. However, if your child has their ears pierced small studs are allowed. **ALL uniform must be labelled, including footwear.** If children wear boots into school they need to change into their black school shoes when they arrive as they are uncomfortable to wear all day.
