Dear Parents and Carers,

## Camp Atwood Friday 14th June – Saturday 15th June 2024

Ahead of our camp this Friday, we are writing with some key information to ensure that all parents and children know what to expect. The weather forecast suggests it's likely to be wet and chilly, so please pack layers for your child to help them keep warm and dry.

The children need to arrive wearing old, comfortable clothes and trainers that they won't mind getting muddy or wet. Please also ensure your child has the correct kit, most importantly:

- water bottle, a sleeping bag, pyjamas (or similar), a torch, a small wash kit and towel and a change of clothes. Teddies are of course welcome to come, too!

Friday 14<sup>th</sup> June - children to arrive at 8.45am and register under the gazebo on the school field.

## All parents will be asked to give their consent for Piriton, Calpol (paracetamol) and/or Nurofen (Ibuprofen) to be given to their child if necessary. Saturday 15<sup>th</sup> June – children to be collected from the school field at 8.30am.

All **medicines** must be given to **Mrs Hutchinson** by a parent/carer in a clearly labelled bag. She will be under the gazebo.

Any child who may **not be fully dry at night** should bring pull-ups to wear. We would ask that a parent/carer discretely tells **Mrs Hutchinson** as they register. We will of course deal with this sensitively and confidentially.

On registration, children will be allocated their tent where they will be asked to leave their luggage. Please provide your child with a mid-morning and afternoon snack. These should be easily accessible at the top of their luggage. Please remember we are a nut-free, healthy school. Children should then make their way to their classroom where they will be met by a school adult. If your child is having a packed lunch, they must put it, as usual, in their class box.

**Camp Atwood** will be going ahead, whatever the weather. We will plan indoor activities just in case it is too wet to be outside.
